

Explore the world's largest sand island by 4WD.

With permit in hand, explore the natural wonders of Fraser Island (K'gari) the world's largest sand island by 4WD. From the barge, head east to Eurong for some of Queensland's best fishing. Marvel at the crystal-clear waters and white sands of Lake McKenzie (Boorangoora) or trek through ancient rainforests before hitting the ocean highway along 75 Mile Beach. Head skyward for breathtaking views of the Maheno Shipwreck and the Pinnacles' colourful cliffs.

Make your way back to Kingfisher Bay for a day of whale-watching. Be dingo safe and make sure your vehicle, skills and knowledge are suitable for the trip.

**Please note:** Fraser Island (K'gari) is an exciting but challenging 4WD adventure and this itinerary is suitable for 4WD vehicles only.

A mapped out route with driving distances **has not** been indicated on this drive as tracks and routes are subject to tide times and weather.

It is important to plan extensively when visiting Fraser Island and be prepared for hazards or track closures.

Signs are found across the Island indicating distances. Please follow all road signs, stick to all inland tracks provided and avoid driving at nighttime.

When navigating applies to driving on the beaches of the Island, it is recommended to avoid driving 2-hours on either side of high tide. Beaches can completely disappear during these times, making them impassable and extremely dangerous for vehicle access.

Please remember that when on Fraser Island (K'gari), you are travelling to a remote part of Australia. As mobile phone reception on the Island can be unreliable, it is important to check weather conditions, tide times and [QPWS Park Alerts](#) before you leave.

- Always take care while driving on the Island and be prepared for hazards. • Plan extensively before visiting and don't rush.
- Ensure that your 4WD can cope with difficult conditions, including deep soft sand, steep and bumpy tracks. Sand driving requires total concentration.
- Take with you a good map of Fraser Island. • Check weather conditions, tide times and [Queensland Parks and Wildlife Service \(QPWS\) Park Alerts](#) before you leave.
- It's important to remember this itinerary is suitable for 4WD vehicles only. Always take care while driving on the island.
- Pack water, food, spare fuel and 4WD recovery gear – there are limited supplies on the island.

- Check for opening hours online for products and to book ahead.
- Fraser Island wongari (dingoes) are part of the island ecology, and are protected by law. Follow all signage and direction on the Island to be dingo safe. Don't walk alone or run when nearby, and always stay close to children. Never feed the dingoes.
- Only experienced off-road drivers with high-clearance 4WD are suitable for the job.
- A vehicle access permit must be purchased. Display the permit on your windscreen before driving in the recreation area.
